On Monday and Thursday evening we held our Assessing Without Levels Information Evenings covering changes that will affect our current Y3-Y5 children. Here the aim was to inform parents of national changes to the way in which we assess children as well as explaining how we will track children here at Sharmans Cross. It was good to have such a big turn out on these evenings and I really hope they were useful, even if you did leave with lots of information to digest! We very much valued your feedback completed after these and have already started looking at your suggestions and questions in order to improve our system of information sharing further. Please don't forget to submit your application for the PTA 100 Club. A further copy of the details can be found under the letters page on our Website. If you would prefer not to send the completed standing order mandate back into school, you can set up your own standing order directly with your Bank or via online banking.

DBS Disclosures (formally known as CRB)

Any parents/volunteers wishing to help within school or on any trips now require an enhanced DBS disclosure to be completed. A 'List 99 check' will no longer be sufficient. If you would like to make an up to date disclosure application, please go to www.disclosure.capitarvs.co.uk/solihull/ click on 'Start Application', in the organisation reference field enter 'SCHSHA', click 'Enter' and leave the password empty. You should then be able to enter your own details and submit your application. Thereafter, you will need to bring three forms of identification into school for verification by ourselves. NB in addition to the standard DBS police checks, we will also request a check on the Children's Barred Listing. In order to keep a DBS certificate live, you need to sign into school once every three months. This could be for a number of reasons including helping in the class, the library, attending a trip, helping with a PTA event set up, attending the children's workshops etc.
