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Dear parents,

As part of the new science curriculum, Year 6 will be taught about Human reproduction. This will fall into three categories:

- -The male and female organs (following on from Year 5 Relationships and Sex Education puberty lessons).
- The growth of a baby from foetus to birth (once fertilisation has occured).
- Gestation periods in mammals.

The non statutory guidance from the government states that:

- -Children should learn about the changes experienced in puberty and pupils should draw a timeline to indicate stages in the growth and development of humans.
- -Children could work scientifically by researching the gestation periods of other animals and comparing them with humans; by finding out and recording the length and mass of a baby as it grows. Please note that intercourse will not be discussed during these lessons.

The lessons will take place on Thursday 9th July. We will be following a PowerPoint for the lessons along with examples of the tasks that the children will complete.
