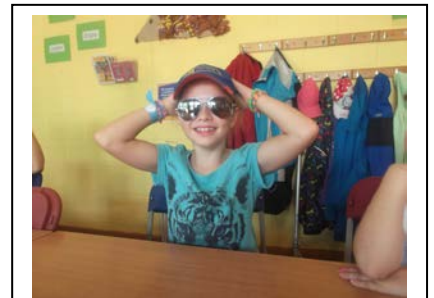
AT SHARMANS CROSS

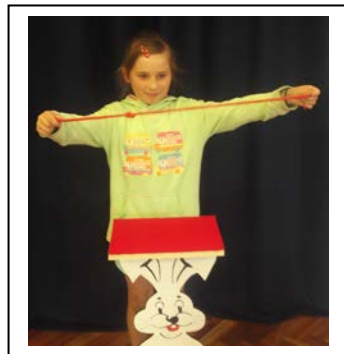
A balloon critter!

The provision recognises the child's need to test boundaries and responds positively to that need

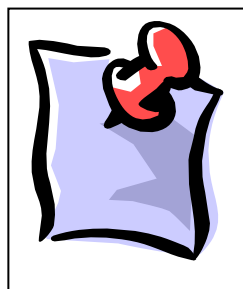
